









Check for Urine Infection

Check for bowels

Urgent need to pass
urine/incontinent
when not usually



Confused
more than usual
when not usually



Feeling feverish and
unwell



Low tummy or
suprapubic pain

*Prolonged contact with urine
can encourage urine infection.
Therefore, it is important to
ensure that Incontinence Pads
are changed in a timely way*

Clients with urinary
catheters are likely to
have bacteria in their
urine – encourage fluids
